CareWell Brings Joy and Happiness to Children living in Delhi Slums on the Occasion of Festival of Lights – 'Diwali'

Sweets and supervised fireworks were distributed among 1,000 children from slums of Delhi studying at Sri Tapovan Vidya Mandir, Delhi; who are facing severe poverty and economic challenges.
